## The Miracles of Jesus

During the 2005 Event Training Day, a few churches asked for a set of questions that they could use to help their clubbers get a feel for what Bible Quizzing is like. In the interest of preserving the integrity of Bible Quizzing, it was necessary to create a set of practice questions that were unrelated to the material found in the handbooks. These questions should be used **ONLY** to help your clubbers get a feel for the format and sequence of Bible Quizzing and **SHOULD NOT** be considered a Bible Quizzing study packet.
